In addition, the bulletin boards at the pool and near the mailboxes are also used to post event and meeting notices.

This year we began charging \$5 per person to attend the parties to cover the cost of food. Monies from our budget are used for any additional expenses, like supplies and entertainment. New party ideas, like Taco Tuesday and March Madness, were tried this year as well as impromptu Music Nights with Art Kopacz providing the music. The Welcome Back cocktail party and the Aloha Party rounded out this year's events. Attendance at the parties has been outstanding with over 100 at the last two events.

We also want to thank everyone for supporting the Lucky 3 Raffles. Proceeds from the drawings are used to purchase items that will enhance Davis Lake and add to the entertainment experience. This year we started with a budget of \$500 and now have around \$900. We have given a \$100 donation to the Landscape Committee, purchased noodles and a stereo boom box for water aerobics. In the past we purchased tables, umbrellas and chairs. This year we hope to buy additional folding chairs for use at the parties and hope to purchase a new bulletin board to announce social activities.

Residents and renters are encouraged to help with the planning and coordinating of the monthly social activities. Meetings are posted and are open to anyone interested in attending. We are looking for new ideas and welcome your suggestions. You may contact any member of the Committee or any Building Captain with your ideas.

We also want to thank all the many volunteers who have helped with baking desserts, setup, and cleanup. This is truly a group effort with the goal of making Davis Lake a fun, social and vibrant community.
